## **"Is Anything Too Hard For God?"**

We know the story of Abraham & Sarah. In **Genesis 12:1-3**, God made a land, nation, & seed promise to Abraham. The nation & seed promise are contingent upon this old man having a son. Remember, God makes these promises to Abraham while he is advanced in age. As the Lord reiterates these promises in **Genesis 18**, Sarah overhears & laughs. Hence, God asked the rhetorical question in **Genesis 18:14**, "*Is anything too hard for the Lord?*" The obvious answer is No! Yet, sometimes our faith suggests that some things are:
